Jesus is Lord!

Who is Jesus?

There is no other Savior, only Jehovah. He is the only one!

"YOU are my witnesses," is the utterance of Jehovah, "even my servant whom I have chosen, in order that YOU may know and have faith in me, and that YOU may understand that I am the same One. Before me there was no God formed, and after me there continued to be none. I—I am Jehovah, and besides me there is no savior." Isaiah 43:10-11*

What does the New Testament say about Jesus?

Go on growing in the undeserved kindness and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him [be] the glory both now and to the day of eternity. 2 Peter 3:18

In answer Thomas said to him: "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him: "Because you have seen me have you believed? Happy are those who do not see and yet believe." John 20:28-29

The Old Testament says Jehovah is the only God and Savior. The New Testament says Jesus is Lord and God and Savior. Jesus is Jehovah in the flesh! That is why in Isaiah 49:16, Jehovah can say, *"Look! Upon [my] palms I have engraved you."*

What did Jesus do to save us?

But God recommends his own love to us in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

By this undeserved kindness, indeed, YOU have been saved through faith; and this not owing to YOU, it is God's gift. No, it is not owing to works, in order that no man should have ground for boasting. For we are a product of his work and were created in union with Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared in advance for us to walk in them. Ephesians 2:8-10

"For even the Son of man came, not to be ministered to, but to minister and to give his soul a ransom in exchange for many." Mark 10:45

He was delivered up for the sake of our trespasses and was raised up for the sake of declaring us righteous. Romans 4:25

The Bible says our sin is like a huge debt to God. It is impossible for us to pay it. Jesus died on the cross to pay that debt. He is the ransom for all people, not just Adam's sin. Jesus died and rose alive again to make us righteous, that is, right with God. All people who believe in Jesus have this gift. Our good works earn nothing for us (see Luke 17:10). Romans 10:2-3 says, *For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God; but not according to accurate knowledge; for, because of not knowing the righteousness of God but seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the righteousness of God. Zeal for God is good. But if we try to show God that we are righteous, then we are setting aside God's gift of true righteousness. Good works are a way for us to thank and praise God. We earn no gift or favor from them. Salvation comes only through faith in Jesus!*

What can you do?

- Let God's word speak to you. Put away your Watchtower and Awake magazines. Read and study only the Bible. 2 Timothy 3:15-16.
- Pray and ask God to show you the truth of His word and the meaning of salvation in Jesus.
- "Believe on the Lord Jesus and you will get saved, you and your household." Acts 16:31
