
Matthew 7:6 (1217). Why would we not forgive someone?

Read John 15:19 (1356). When we love unbelievers, sometimes they won't like it. When that happens, we can take comfort in the fact that God still _____ us and that Jesus _____ us to belong to Him.

Exploring God's Love

The Bible says “We love because God loved us first” (1 John 4:19). In our first two studies, we saw how God loved us first. In the third study, we learned how God gives believers special love for each other. How do we love unbelievers? The same or different? In this study, we will look at how God gives us love for all people.

Loving Christians vs. Loving Unbelievers

Give your thoughts. Do you think loving believers and unbelievers is the same, or do we love believers one way and unbelievers another way? Why?

Ephesians 4:15-16 (p. 1469) gives one goal for Christian love. When Christians love each other, what happens? Does this happen when Christians love unbelievers?

We can have close relationships with both believers and unbelievers. Can an unbeliever be as close to us as a believer? Read 2 Corinthians 6:14-18 (1452). Why do you think this is?

1. Believers should be kind, polite, obeying the government, and ready to do good. Titus 3:1-2 (1501).

3. Read 1 Peter 3:8-9, 15-16 (1527). Verse 15 says that we should always be ready to explain our _____ in God, and our _____ should support our words. If we love unbelievers, this is how we witness to them.
4. We should even love our _____ Matthew 5:38-48 (1215). We should love others without expecting them to _____ (verse 46). Also see Luke 10:25-37. Who is our neighbor? How deep is our love?
