Acts 3:1-10.

- Who did Peter and John meet by the temple?
- What did the lame man want?
- What did Peter and John give the lame man?
- Notice how the man thanked God. What should we do when God does great things for us?
- What do we have that we can give and share with people?

Acts 3:11-16.

- Who healed the lame man?
- The lame man is now walking and running in the temple! The people should praise who – Peter, God, or the lame man?
- We do good things for other people. We help other people. Who should they thank – us or God?
- Which was more important, Peter and John healing the lame man, or preaching to the people? Why?

Acts 3:17-26.

- When the Jews and Romans killed Jesus, did the Jews understand Jesus was God's Son and our Savior?

- What did Peter say the people should do, and what will God do?
