Acts 18:1-4.

- Paul was in Athens waiting for Silas and Timothy. They didn't come yet, so Paul went to Corinth. How did Paul stay busy in Corinth?

Acts 18:5-8.

- What did Paul do when Silas and Timothy came from Macedonia?
- Why do you think he was waiting for them before he started full-time mission work?
- Why did Paul shake out his clothes? (Hint: read Matthew 10:14)
- Where did the new Christian church meet?

Acts 18:9-17.

- God told Paul he shouldn't be afraid. What did God promise Paul?
- What did the Jews do to Paul?

- Did God keep His promise?

Acts 18:18-22.

- Who sailed to go to Syria?
- Where were Silas and Timothy?
- Where did Priscilla and Aquila stay?
- The people in Ephesus wanted Paul to stay. That would make sense for Paul to stay, right? Why did Paul leave? Did Paul want to follow what he wanted or what God wanted?
