

Nicene Creed

(English version)

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible.

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father, by whom all things were made; who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven and was incarnate of the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary, and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate. He suffered and was buried. And the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures and ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of the Father. And He will come again with glory to judge both the living and the dead, whose kingdom will have no end.

And I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the prophets. And I believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church. I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins, and I look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Nicene Creed

(Simple English version)

We believe in one God, the Father Almighty. He made heaven and earth, all things I see and can't see.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, God's only Son. Long ago before the world began, Jesus was with the Father. God from God, Light from Light, True God from true God. The Father did not make the Son. The Son and the Father are one God, the same. The Son made all things. To save us, the Son came down from heaven. Through the Holy Spirit, the Son received a body in the Virgin Mary, and He became a man. During Pontius Pilate's reign, the Son got crucified instead of us. He suffered and was buried. The third day He rose according to the Bible. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of the Father. The Son, full of glory, will come to judge people living and dead. His kingdom will never end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, Himself the Lord and Life-Giver. The Holy Spirit comes from the Father and the Son. The Holy Spirit, Father, Son, together we worship and glorify.
